

In September 2022:

26 children reporting pushbacks to BiH (12%).

52 people reported physical abuse or assault.


Assistance provided:


A total of **29** direct assistances were provided to persons reporting pushback incidents, mainly in terms of food (FI) and non-food (NFI) item delivery, and first-aid psychosocial assistance.


Additionally, a total of **65** referrals were conducted by DRC staff to relevant service, including but not limited to reception facilities, registration in the country, medical assistance, or direct assistance in terms of FI & NFI distribution.


% OF PERSONS* REPORTING SPECIFIC TYPE OF VIOLATIONS DURING PUSHBACK INCIDENT












OF PERSONS* REPORTING PUSHBACKS FROM CROATIA TO BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA
