

167 persons* reporting pushbacks from Croatia to BiH in February 2024



No chain pushback incidents were recorded.

Breakdown per Country of Origin Morocco- 75 persons Syria - 47 persons Egypt- 17 persons Nepal - 12 persons DR Congo - 3 persons Other countries - 13 persons

In February 2024:

23 children reporting pushbacks to BiH.

155 people reported physical abuse or assault.

Assistance provided:

total of **222** direct assistances were rovided to persons reporting pushback incidents, ainly in terms of food (FI) and non-food (NFI) item elivery, first-aid medical assistance and first-aid sychosocial assistance.


Additionally, a total of **104** referrals were conducted by DRC staff to relevant service, ncluding but not limited to reception facilities, registration in the country, medical assistance, or direct assistance in terms of FI & NFI distribution.

384 persons* reporting pushbacks to BiH.
