

% OF PERSONS* REPORTING SPECIFIC TYPE OF VIOLATIONS DURING PUSHBACK INCIDENT








Denial of access to asylum

In March 2022:

34 children reporting pushbacks to BiH (9%). A significant increase in number of persons reporting physical abuse or assault, abusive/degrading treatment and theft, extortion or destruction of property compared to the previous month.

Assistance provided:


A total of **121** direct assistances were provided to persons reporting pushback incidents, mainly in terms of food (FI) and non-food (NFI) item delivery, first-aid medical assistance and first-aid psychosocial assistance.

Additionally, a total of **401** referrals were conducted by DRC staff to relevant service, including but not limited to reception facilities, registration in the country, medical assistance, or direct assistance in terms of FI & NFI distribution.

Total for 2022:

1.068 persons* reporting pushbacks to BiH.
