



217 persons* reporting pushbacks from Croatia to BiH in January 2024

No chain pushback incidents were recorded.

In January 2024:

30 children reporting pushbacks to BiH.

164 people reported physical abuse or assault.

Assistance provided:

A total of **138** direct assistances were provided to persons reporting pushback incidents, mainly in terms of food (FI) and non-food (NFI) item delivery, first-aid medical assistance and first-aid psychosocial assistance.

Additionally, a total of **90** referrals were conducted by DRC staff to relevant service, including but not limited to reception facilities, registration in the country, medical assistance, or direct assistance in terms of FI & NFI distribution.

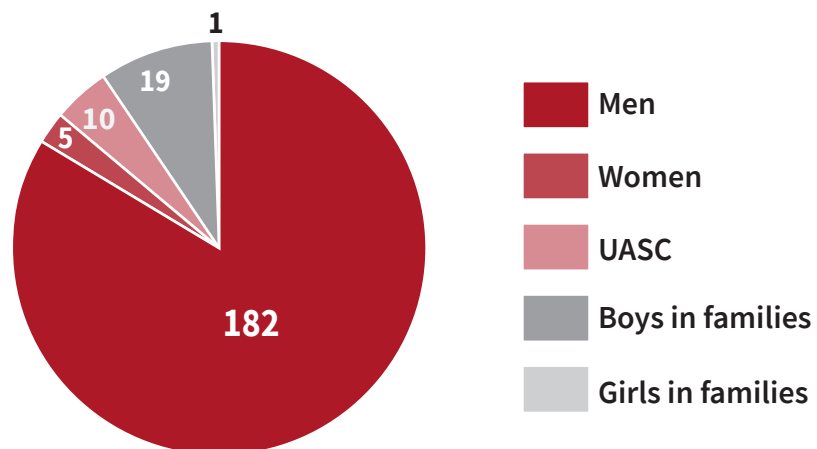
Total for 2024:

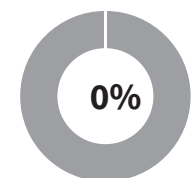

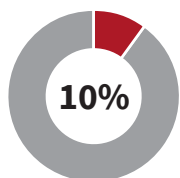
Breakdown per Country of Origin

- Other countries - **18 persons**

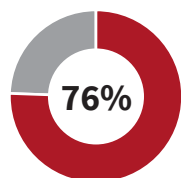
% OF PERSONS* REPORTING SPECIFIC TYPE OF VIOLATIONS DURING PUSHBACK INCIDENT



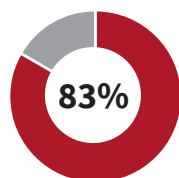

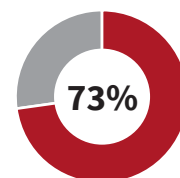
Denial of access to asylum
