

52 children reporting pushbacks to BiH.


282 people reported physical abuse or assault.

Assistance provided:


A total of 478 direct assistances were provided to persons reporting pushback incidents, mainly in terms of food (FI) and non-food (NFI) item delivery, first-aid medical assistance and first-aid psychosocial assistance.

Additionally, a total of **141** referrals were conducted by DRC staff to relevant service, ncluding but not limited to reception facilities, registration in the country, medical assistance, or direct assistance in terms of FL& NFL distribution.

% OF PERSONS* REPORTING SPECIFIC TYPE OF VIOLATIONS DURING PUSHBACK INCIDENT









Abusive/degrading treatment


