

No chain pushback incidents were recorded.




Breakdown per Country of Origin

In November 2023:

24 children reporting pushbacks to BiH.

92 people reported physical abuse or assault.

Assistance provided:


A total of **170** direct assistances were provided to persons reporting pushback incidents, mainly in terms of food (FI) and non-food (NFI) item delivery, first-aid medical assistance and first-aid psychosocial assistance.

Additionally, a total of 140 referrals were conducted by DRC staff to relevant service, including but not limited to reception facilities, registration in the country, medical assistance, or direct assistance in terms of FI & NFI distribution.

Total for 2023:

3.210 persons* reporting pushbacks to BiH.
