

282 persons* reporting pushbacks from Croatia to BiH in May 2022

No chain pushback incidents were recorded.



Breakdown per Country of Origin

Pakistan - 83 persons
Afghanistan - 52 persons
Bangladesh - 34 persons
Nepal - 33 persons
Eritrea - 17 persons
Iraq - 17 persons
Cameroon - 14 persons
Congo - 7 persons
Egypt - 6 persons
Other - 19 persons

In May 2022:

36 children reporting pushbacks to BiH (13%).

Assistance provided:

A total of **59** direct assistances were provided to persons reporting pushback incidents, mainly in terms of food (FI) and non-food (NFI) item delivery, first-aid medical assistance and first-aid psychosocial assistance.

Additionally, a total of **27** referrals were conducted by DRC staff to relevant service, including but not limited to reception facilities, registration in the country, medical assistance, or direct assistance in terms of FI & NFI distribution.

Abusive/degrading treatment


