



% OF PERSONS* REPORTING SPECIFIC TYPE OF VIOLATIONS DURING PUSHBACK INCIDENT











In May 2023:

12 children reporting pushbacks to BiH (12%).

195 people reported physical abuse or assault.

Assistance provided:

A total of **284** direct assistances were provided to persons reporting pushback incidents, mainly in terms of food (FI) and non-food (NFI) item delivery, first-aid medical assistance and first-aid psychosocial assistance.

Additionally, a total of **136** referrals were conducted by DRC staff to relevant service, including but not limited to reception facilities, registration in the country, medical assistance, or direct assistance in terms of FI & NFI distribution.

Total for 2023:

834 persons* reporting pushbacks to BiH.
