66
children reporting pushbacks to $\mathrm{BiH}(22 \%)$. The number of persons reporting pushbacks in January 2022 compared to January 2021 has increased by 44\%.

## Assistance provided:

A total of 11 direct assistances were provided to persons reporting pushback incidents, mainly in terms of food (FI) and non-food (NFI) item delivery, first-aid medical assistance and first-aid psychosocial assistance.
Additionally, a total of $\mathbf{1 7 5}$ referrals were conducted by DRC staff to relevant service, including but not limited to reception facilities, registration in the country, medical assistance, or direct assistance in terms of FI \& NFI distribution.
