

Morocco - 3 persons



Physical abuse or assault



OF PERSONS* REPORTING PUSHBACKS FROM CROATIA TO BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA



In January 2023:

- **9** children reporting pushbacks to BiH (8%)
- 4 people reported physical abuse or assault.

Assistance provided:

A total of 50 direct assistances were provided to persons reporting pushback incidents, mainly in terms of food (FI) and mon-food (NFI) item delivery, first-aid medical assistance and first-aid psychosocial assistance.

Additionally, a total of 56 referrals were conducted by DRC staff to relevant service including but not limited to reception facilities registration in the country, medical assistance, odirect assistance in terms of FI & NFI distribution

Total for 2023:

63 persons* reporting pushbacks to BiH.

- * The number of persons reporting pushbacks does not necessarily represent the number of unique individuals, as the same individual(s) may experience repeated pushbacks to BiH. However, repeated cases represent distinct instances of pushbacks. Each pushback is recorded as a separate case
