## In June 2022:

7 children reporting pushbacks to $\mathrm{BiH}(4 \%)$. A significant increase in number of persons reporting arbitrary arrest or detention, physical abuse and theft, extortion or destruction of property compared to the previous month.

## Assistance provided:

A total of $\mathbf{2 0}$
assistances were provided ng pushback incidents, mainly in terms of food (FI) and non-food (NFI) item delivery, first-aid medical assistance and first-aid psychosocial assistance.
Additionally, a total of $\mathbf{6 7}$ referrals were conducted by DRC staff to relevant service, including but not limited to reception facilities, registration in the country, medical assistance, or direct assistance in terms of FI \& NFI distribution.

## Total for 2022:

1.837 persons' reporting pusthacks to BiH.
