


# In June 2022:


**7** children reporting pushbacks to BiH (4%). A significant increase in number of persons reporting arbitrary arrest or detention, physical abuse and theft, extortion or destruction of property compared to the previous month.

## Assistance provided:

A total of **20** direct assistances were provided to persons reporting pushback incidents, mainly in terms of food (FI) and non-food (NFI) item delivery, first-aid medical assistance and first-aid psychosocial assistance.

Additionally, a total of **67** referrals were conducted by DRC staff to relevant service, including but not limited to reception facilities, registration in the country, medical assistance, or direct assistance in terms of FI & NFI distribution.

### % OF PERSONS\* REPORTING SPECIFIC TYPE OF VIOLATIONS DURING PUSHBACK INCIDENT









Abusive/degrading treatment


